

CHURCH STRUCTURE

Believers who dedicate their hearts, time, families and finances to building the local Church deserve a church leadership they can trust.

EMMANUIL CHURCH IS ORGANISED AND LED BY THE FOLLOWING GROUPS OF MINISTERS

1 COUNCIL OF BISHOPS

Provides spiritual mentorship to the senior pastor and oversees the teaching of the church in accordance with Holy Scripture. The mentors are three bishops/pastors from other respected congregations who love Emmanuel Church and its pastors and are willing when necessary to offer spiritual assistance, correction or counsel. They may be invited by the church's spiritual council to assist with matters of senior-pastor accountability or in cases where the senior pastor fails to uphold theological, moral or financial ethical standards. The mentors serve as apostolic elders.

2 SPIRITUAL COUNCIL

Responsible for analysing, reflecting on, and confirming with the Word of God the church's vision, overall strategy and development processes, providing spiritual correction, approval and blessing for implementation in the life of the church. The senior pastor leads the Spiritual Council. Meetings are held once every two months.

3 LEAD PASTORS

Responsible for receiving and implementing the vision, and for the overall direction, growth and spiritual development of the church. They lead gatherings, teach the Word, strengthen the leadership, and serve the needs of people. The lead pastors of the church are the senior pastor and campus pastors. Campus pastors oversee the development and activities of each department of the church to ensure that ministry remains aligned with the church's vision and that methods of ministry are consistent with the principles of Scripture and the values of the church. They work closely with department leaders and are accountable to the senior pastor and spiritual council. Meetings are held once a week.

4 COUNCIL OF DEPARTMENT LEADERS

Responsible for the direct implementation and execution of all approved and assigned tasks, each within their own area of ministry. Ministry leaders are the heads of the church's departments, through which the vision of the church and the strategy of ministry are carried out.
