I. TRANSFORMED CHARACTER

We understand the importance of a transformed Character. Every follower of Jesus Christ should, in his daily life, increasingly distance himself from a worldly way of life and reflect the qualities of Christ ever more clearly.

IN CHURCH MINISTRY, IT IS VITAL THAT THESE QUALITIES BE EXPRESSED:

- 1 Integrity. Decency, honesty, conscientiousness
- 2 Dedication. Quality, striving for excellence
- 3 Generosity. Virtue, self-sacrifice
- 4 Warmth. Goodwill, hospitality

II. THE BLESSING OF FELLOWSHIP

We understand the importance and benefit of relationships within the church family. The apostles in the New Testament use the phrase *"one another"* dozens of times in a variety of contexts.

The Church is the Body of the Lord Jesus Christ. Each person is a part — a member of that body. Isolation is destructive, while **relationships bring enormous benefit** to each person and to all.

III. DISCOVERING CALLING

We understand the importance of every person discovering their **personal God-given purpose**. The two greatest days in your life: the day you were born, and the day you discovered why. It is vital to help people find their calling, because happiness is found in fulfilling one's purpose.

The question of purpose was life-defining for the apostle Paul. When he encountered Christ, he asked **two vital questions**:

- Who are You, Lord?
- What do You want me to do?

IV. THE VALUE OF WITNESS

We understand the practical importance for every person who has believed in Jesus Christ and followed Him to carry out His mission in their life.

He commanded us to go into society — to friends, neighbours, and those far off. Beyond the special services of the church, every believer should share their faith: telling their story of a personal relationship with God and bringing people to Jesus, helping them to follow Him.
